Male Mental Health Focus

College assemblies this week have had a focus on male mental health and Movember. We would encourage parents to discuss this topic with students to further the conversation around male mental health. There are a number of ways in which support can be accessed both in school and out of school. In school, students can speak to tutors, college and assistant college leaders and the safeguarding team.
