What is Peer Mentoring?

It is our hope that whoever is successful in securing one of these roles will be instrumental in promoting and instilling our core values of respect, success, and aspiration.

Who can apply?

When will mentoring take place?

Students will be expected to use some of their social time to deliver mentoring.

How can students apply?

Those interested will be required to write a letter of application (no longer than one side of A4) to Mr Cleary (Principal), detailing why they feel suited to the role and how they would apply their skills to support others. Training will be compulsory and provided by the school, however, please note that most of this training will be completed at home. **The deadline for applications is Wednesday 17**th **January.**

Students who apply for this position will be selected for interview with the Mr Cleary (Principal) and will be provided with a detailed debrief on their performance. Students who are successful will be awarded with a **Peer Mentoring badge** and the **opportunity to complete the SSAT Student Leadership Accreditation**.
