If more than two nominations are received, we will need to hold an election. In that event parents will receive a Notice of Poll, details of candidates and ballot papers on Friday 15th November 2024. All ballot papers have to be returned to Robert Smyth Academy by 12:00 on Friday, 22nd November. Ballot papers will be counted on 25th November and the outcome published that day.
