

Robert Smyth Academy Sixth Form Dress Code

Our expectation is that Robert Smyth Sixth Form students will take pride in their appearance and in their membership of our learning community.

Our expectation is that students attend in smart business wear.

Examples of Acceptable Items

- 1. A smart collared shirt / blouse (which can include a polo shirt)
- 2. A tailored jacket (optional)
- 3. A tie (optional)
- 4. A smart jumper or cardigan (optional)
- 5. Smart, non-denim, ankle-length trousers
- 6. A smart, non-denim skirt or dress, close to the knee in length
- 7. Smart, formal shoes

Examples of Unacceptable Items

- Sportswear/Athleisure wear. This includes sports footwear (trainers, Vans, Converse or similar), hoodies and sweatshirts, excessively baggy clothing or tight leggings.
- 2. See-through clothing.
- 3. Clothing that causes offence through either language, slogans or imagery.
- 4. Denim and leather/leather-look clothes.
- 5. In addition to appropriate clothing, all students are expected to maintain a smart appearance with no extreme piercings, tattoos or hairstyles. Hair dye, if used, should be of a natural tone.

Notes

- 1. Polo shirts must be plain (small, unobtrusive logos are acceptable).
- 2. Shirts and blouses must be tucked in, including polo shirts.
- 3. Hats and coats should not be worn inside Academy buildings.
- 4. You are welcome to check with the Academy before purchasing if you are unsure of the suitability of items of clothing / footwear.

Students who fail to comply with the dress code will be removed from circulation and might be sent home to change.

Persistent refusal to comply with the dress code will result in removal from the Academy.
