Personal statement

- 47 Lines of text, maximum of 4,000 characters
- Opportunity to show suitability for the course
- Why do you want to study your course?
- How have you explored and developed the subject?

Top tips

- Encourage research around subject choice. There are 50,000 courses.
- Encourage students to verbalise learnings from their experiences
- Book Open Days advance
- Support, but don't do it for them!
